The October 15th, 2024 Town of Tioga budget workshop was brought to order at 6:00pm. Present were Councilman Drew Griffin, Councilman Paul Welch, Councilman Robert Strong with Supervisor Douglas Chrzanowski presiding.

Also present was Highway Superintendent Russell Story, Bookkeeper Melanie Sinsabaugh, Kris Morris, Jordan Douglas, Rusty Stoughton and Andrew Klossner.

The presented 2025 Tentative Budget was discussed.

- 1. 4% pay increase to all employees
- A \$10,000.00 increase to Park Contractual A7110.4 for park bathroom updating
- 3. Led sign money from Building Contractual A1620.4 to Building Equipment A1620.2
- 4. Road mower paid from Highway side / cemetery and parks paid from separate line now
- 5. Secured broom and backhoe funding
- 6. Dropping the uniform service Unifirst as of the first of the year and giving a \$550.00 clothing stipend for each highway employee per fiscal year.

Councilman Griffin made the motion to adopt the 2025 Tentative Budget as presented and move to the Preliminary Budget, Councilman Strong seconded, carried.
